Your plan has been issued the unique identification number shown above. Please be sure to include this number in any communication to the FAA regarding your program.

Federal Aviation Regulations require submission of semiannual and annual reports to the FAA Office of Aviation Medicine. Initial reports should be submitted by August 15, 1991, and should cover the period from initial implementation of your program through June 30, 1991. A sample reporting format is enclosed. Reports may be submitted directly to FAA, or through your approved consortium, depending on the terms of your membership.
